## Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university
- 3.0 grade point average
- Official undergraduate transcripts from awarding institution
- Written statement of educational philosophy and professional goals
- Two confidential appraisals from administrators or supervisors of your professional and personal skills
- Completed application
- \$100 refundable tuition deposit, applied toward education costs

## Proficiencies

Students should...

- Be proficient in using computers for research, word processing, spreadsheets, and presentations.
- Have a working knowledge of descriptive statistics.

## Technical Requirements for Internet Communication with Concordia
