-All credit hour requirements are based on the semester academic calendar.

**-Concordia University minimum credit hour requirements are listed in parentheses. Some approved substitution courses have fewer credit hours than the CUAA general studies minimum, making it necessary to take more than one course to fulfill the requirement. One course may not be used to fulfill two different CUAA general studies requirements.**

-Non-repeated credits for all courses numbered 100 and above with grades of C- or better are accepted as general electives if they do not fit into the above requirements or a program/major/minor/concentration.

-Credits from community colleges may be accepted for programs, majors, minors, or concentrations. Final decisions on particular courses are made by the appropriate dean, division chair, or department chair of Concordia University.

-A grade of C- (1.6667) or better is required for transfer courses.
