Housing Contract Agreement

Welcome to Concordia University Ann Arbor residence life! We are excited that you will be joining our community. For additional information about on-campus housing, please see the Student Handbook (available on the CUAA website).

While every effort will be made to comply with the student preference of roommate choice, the university makes all final housing determinations. In the event a resident vacates a room, the remaining resident may be assigned a new roommate or be re-assigned to another room if determined necessary. If a resident chooses to move into a single room, the additional private room fee will be charged on a prorated basis, until a roommate is assigned. Room or roommate changes must follow the guidelines outlined in the Student Handbook.

Every resident is responsible for the cleanliness and maintenance of his or her room and is liable for any damages to the residence hall property or furnishings in his or her room resulting from abuse or lack of care.

Residence hall contracts are for the Fall and Spring semester terms of the academic year. This contract does not provide room and board during officially designated vacation periods. A \$15.00 charge is assessed per night for remaining on campus during vacation periods.

Any personal effects, valuables, or property of the resident left in the residence hall at the close of the academic year will become the property of the university. If the resident chooses not to return after the first semester, any personal effects, valuables, or property left in the residence hall becomes property of the university.

Residents are responsible for their guests and are accountable for complying with guidelines as stated in the Student Handbook.

Concordia University is interested in the health and well-being of our campus community members. Therefore, smoking is prohibited in all buildings on campus, including residence halls.

Concordia University reserves the right to make periodic room inspections for fire, health, safety, and security purposes. This includes entering rooms to look for suspected policy violations. The Resident Assistant, Resident Director, Department of Public Safety or other authorized university administrators may enter a student's room for these purposes without prior notification.

The university may terminate this agreement and take possession of the room or re-assign the resident(s) to another room or residence hall for violation of any university regulations as found in the Student Handbook, for health or social reasons, or for any reason deemed sufficient by the Vice President of Student Services and/or the Director of Housing. No refund of the room or board will be issued to students who are removed from the residence hall for policy violations.

Students who intend to withdraw from Concordia University Ann Arbor must complete a withdrawal form.
