Dear Veteran,

Concordia University–Ann Arbor has established a scholarship to recognize Veterans whose service to the United States has contributed to the freedoms revered by Concordia University. The Veteran’s Day scholarship is available to a **new** undergraduate student enrolling at Concordia University-Ann Arbor in the fall of 2010 or fall of 2011.

Veteran’s Day Scholarship Parameters:

- 1) The student designated by the Veteran’s Day Scholarship must be applying for *full-time* undergraduate admission to Concordia University-Ann Arbor as a: current high school senior, eligible college transfer student, or adult working toward the completion of their first Bachelor of Arts degree.
- 2) The student must *not be a current Concordia-Ann Arbor student or have previously applied to Concordia University–Ann Arbor* for the term the scholarship is requested
- 3) Original scholarship certificate must be submitted at the time of application.
- 4) Application procedures and academic standards must be met. This scholarship requires a minimum 2.5 cumulative entrance GPA.
- 5) The designated student must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) located free online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Concordia’s school code is 002247.
- 6) Scholarship expiration August 31, 2011.
- 7) Application to Concordia is free online at: www.cuaa.edu. When asked “How did you first learn about Concordia University Ann Arbor?” indicate ‘other’ and input Concordia Veteran’s Leadership Scholarship.
- 8) Complete the certificate by filling in your name and contact information as the veteran referral. Have the student print their name on the scholarship voucher and return at the time of application to: Office of Undergraduate Admission, 4090 Geddes Rd., Ann Arbor MI 48105.
- 9) The certificate is renewable (maximum 4 years) pending student’s satisfactory academic progress and financial aid policies in effect. Limit one scholarship certificate per person.
