**Definition:** 12-Month Enrollment reports how many students were uniquely enrolled at Concordia during the last fiscal year. This is contrasted with the Fall Census, which reports a snapshot of how many students were enrolled on a specified day in October in the fall term. 12-month Enrollment reports the number of students served over the course of an **entire** fiscal year.

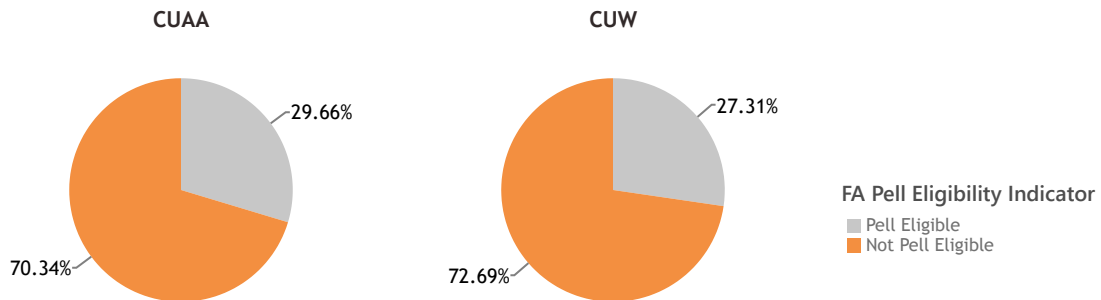

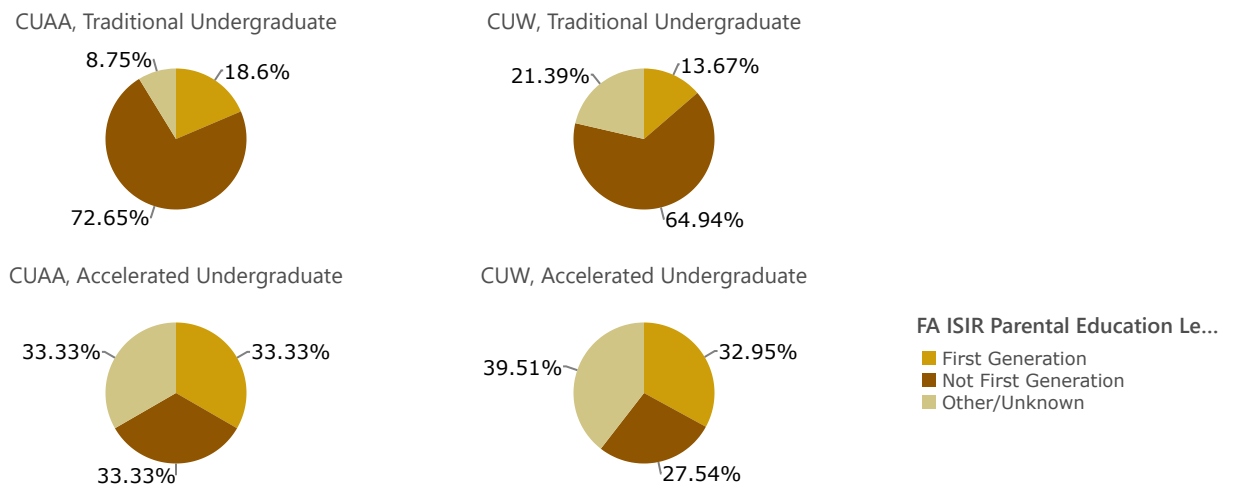

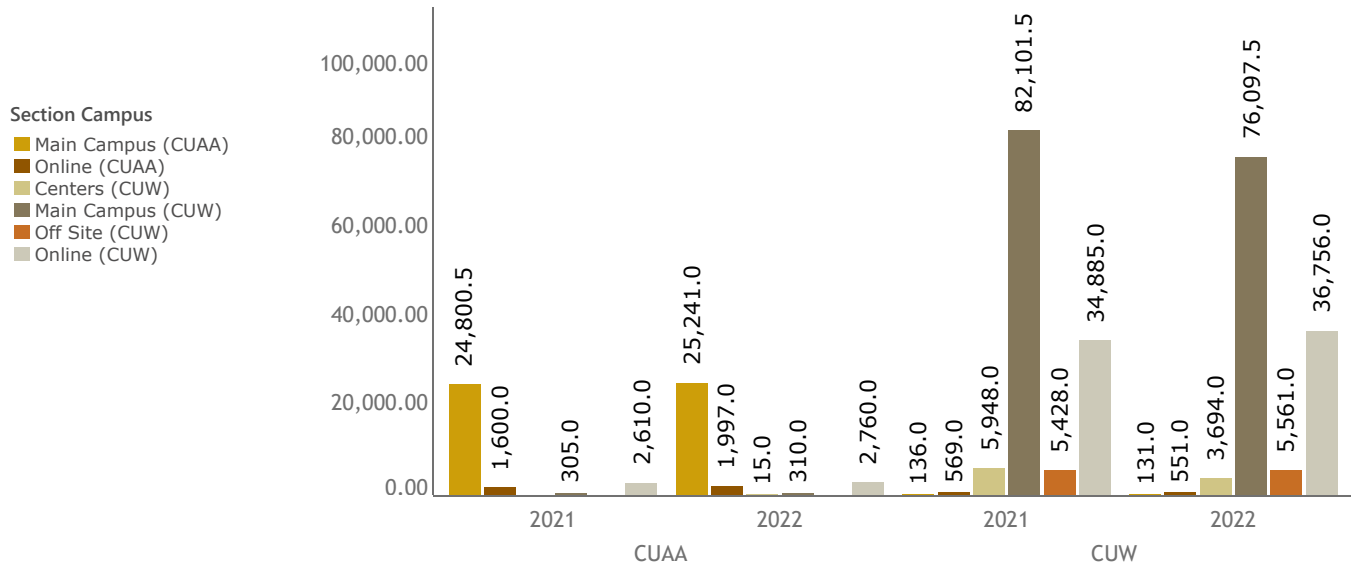

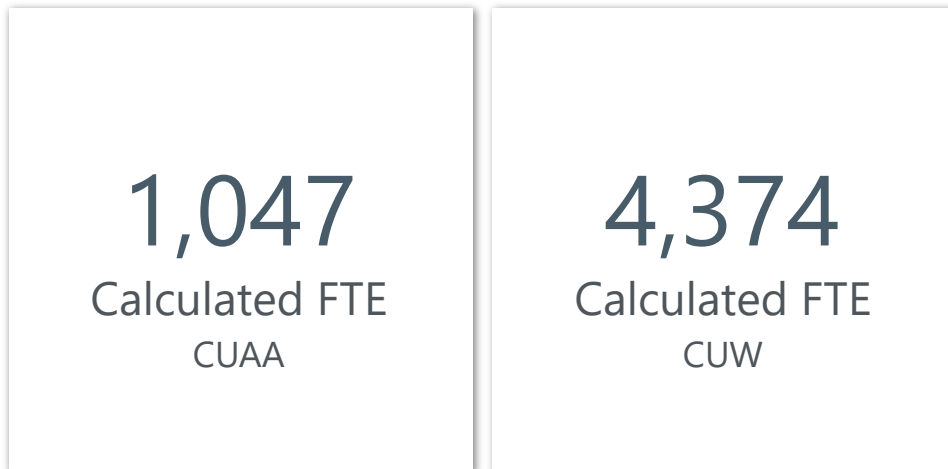
## Instructional Activity (Credits Enrolled) By Location

Note: Calculated FTE is a statistical estimate used by the US Department of Education of the number of students enrolled Full-time for the full academic year. The formula is:

Calculated FTE = Undergraduate Credits / 30 + Graduate Credits / 24 + Raw Professional Enrollment.
