



Survey of Graduates – 2022-23 Academic Year Summary Report

Graduates of Concordia University Ann Arbor are surveyed annually during their month of graduation to assess student satisfaction with various aspects of their college experience. During the 2022-23 academic year, responses were received from 63 of 154 undergraduate students (41%) and 23 of 74 graduate students (31%). In total, 86 of 228 students (38%) responded.



