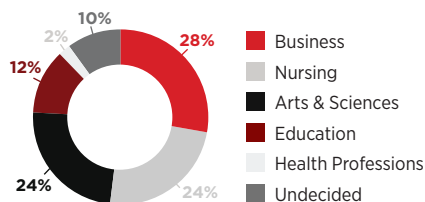

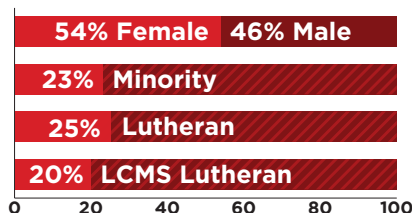

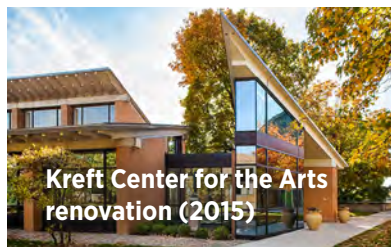
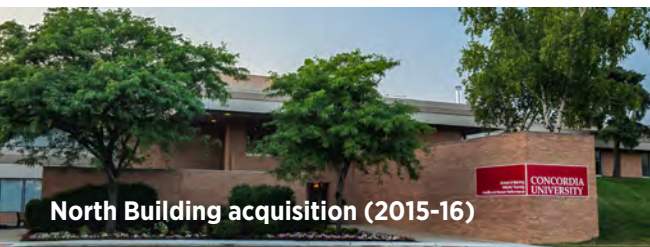

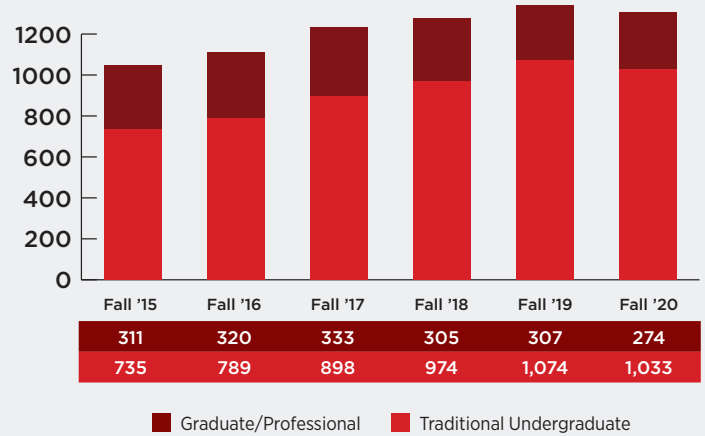


Over the past five years, CUAAs enrollment has grown faster than any of the 29 member MICU schools

CUAA 12-MONTH ENROLLMENT TREND



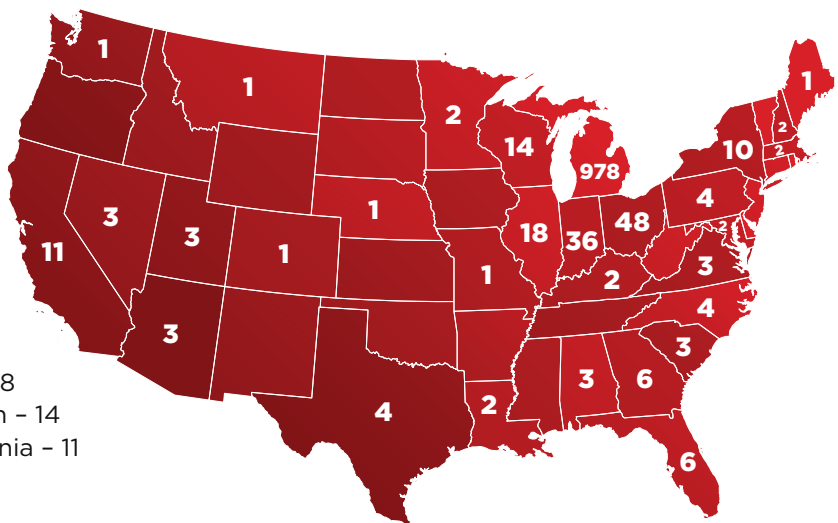

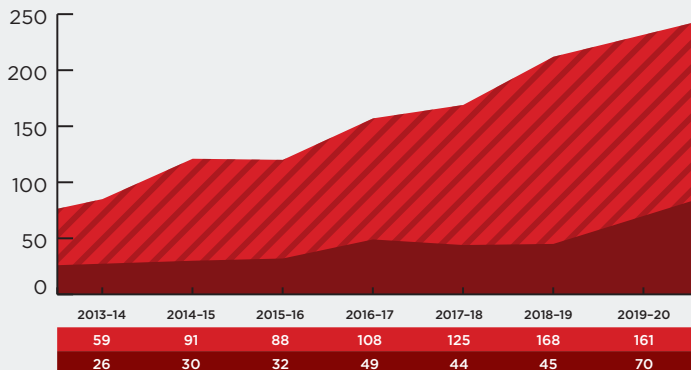

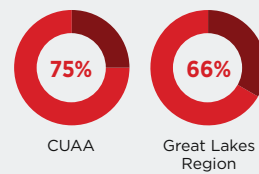

NUMBER OF DEGREES CONFERRED BY YEAR

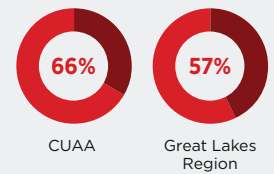

Employed six months after graduation

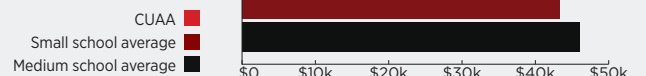


Employed full-time six months after graduation

Mean starting salary after graduation with a bachelor's degree



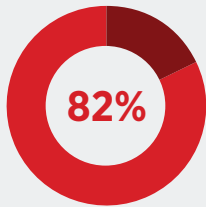

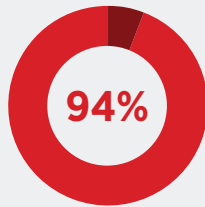
