Transfer Opportunities for Ann Arbor Students between Concordia University Wisconsin & Ann Arbor and Walsh College

I. INTRODUCTION

Concordia University Wisconsin & Ann Arbor (CUWAA), an institution of higher education accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) and Walsh College, an institution of higher learning accredited by the Higher Learning commission (HLC) have outlined transfer opportunities for students currently enrolled on the Concordia University Ann Arbor campus.

Walsh College is an upper-division private college offering business and technology degrees. Walsh College will offer waiver of application fees when students on the Ann Arbor campus apply to the institution. Additionally, upon receipt of unofficial student transcripts, the Walsh College admissions team will expedite evaluations and will accept as many credits as possible, as allowed by college. Walsh College will request official transcripts on behalf of students that have checked the "Consent Release" on the application for admission.

Students who are entering transfer programs at Walsh College will need to have a minimum of 36 semester credit hours completed with a grade of "C" or higher to meet admission requirements. Students are eligible for all bachelor's degree programs offered at Walsh College. All credits transferred to or accepted by CUWAA and listed on the academic transcript will be accepted directly by Walsh College. Upon applying to Walsh College, student transcripts will be evaluated. Based on the transcript evaluation, students will be offered the best transfer pathway for degree completion and credit acceptance. Additional course equivalencies not found in the Walsh College Transfer Course Equivalency Database will be evaluated for equivalency.

II. Transferring Student Admission Process

- 1. Complete the Walsh College Application for Admission at <u>Apply Now | Walsh Graduate & Undergraduate Business Degrees (walshcollege.edu)</u>.
- 2. Check the "Consent Release/Request" box on the application for admission to allow Walsh College to request all official transcripts on behalf of student and pay the associated fees.
- 3. For International Students: In addition to the items listed above, required F-1 International Student documents will need to be completed and submitted. F-1 International students will work with Walsh College's international student admissions and International Student Coordinator/PDSO for required I-20 and Visa documentation.

IV. Program Completion at Walsh College

Walsh College offers the following bachelor's degrees with unlimited transfer credits:

- 1. A Bachelor of Accountancy (BAC) degree requires 120 credits with minimum residency of 45 credits.
- 2. A Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree requires 120 credits with minimum residency of 42 credits.
- 3. A Bachelor of Science in Applied Management (BSAM) degree requires 120 credits with minimum residency of 30 credits.
- 4. A Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (BSIT) degree requires 120 credits with minimum residency of 45 credits.
 - The minimum residency requirement at Walsh College may be reduced to 33-36 credits if directly equivalent junior/senior level credits are applicable to the BAC, BBA, or BSIT degrees.

V. Eligibility for Admission at Walsh College

- 1. Completion of an associate degree satisfies admission requirements for Walsh College bachelor's degrees.
 - All bachelor's degree-seeking students may pursue a Fast Track option to a master's degree completing their associate, bachelor's, and master's degrees in as few as 138 credits.
 - Students with a minimum of 36 semester credit hours completed at the 100/1000 level or higher with a grade of "C" or higher meet admission requirements for the BAC, BBA, and BSIT degrees.
- 2. The Walsh College application for admission includes an opt-in consent for Walsh College to request transcripts on behalf of the student for admission purposes, with no cost to the applicant.
- 3. Credits for courses 1000 level or higher completed with a grade of "C" or higher will transfer to Walsh College. Courses are evaluated by course descriptions and/or course syllabi/outcomes.
- 4. Transfer plans outlining specific associate degree pathways through CUWAA to Walsh College bachelor's degrees are outlined and will be available on each school's website and in Exhibit A of this document. The agreement includes the transfer of all credits for the associate degree and additional courses/credits to maximize transfer credit.
 - Students may pursue any bachelor's degrees at Walsh College with the two best fit options outlined in Exhibit A.

- 5. Fast Track pathways are available for all bachelor's degrees allowing students to complete their associate degree, bachelor's degree, and master's degree in as few as 138 credits.
- 6. This agreement includes and outlines the following specific pathways to a bachelor's degree at Walsh College.
 - a. Associate of Arts General Business Concentration to Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) General Business Major
 - b. Associate of Arts any concentration to Bachelor of Science in Applied Management (BSAM)
- 7. Responsibility for communication related to this agreement will rest with the VP for Academics, AVP of Academic & Student Success, and the VP for Student Success at Concordia University and the Director, Community College, and International Student Relations for Walsh College, or their designees.
- 8. This agreement is in effect immediately upon signature.
